Credentialing At Convention (Mandatory to Vote in the Saturday Elections and Sunday Board of Directors Meeting):

Chapter Voting Delegates are as follows for Board Meeting: Chapter Membership 0-19 (1) Delegate, Chapter Membership 20-100 (2) Delegates, Chapter Membership 101+ (3) Delegates. For **State Elections:** 19 or less regular members=1 vote; 20 regular members=3 votes; A chapter shall be entitled to one (1) additional vote for each additional ten (10) regular members. No regular members shall be counted as a member of more than one (1) affiliated chapter of this Corporation in determining chapter votes hereunder. For purposes of state elections chapter membership shall be determined based on the number of regular members in the chapter as of midnight on July 31, 2009.

All voting delegates must check in at the credentials table on Friday evening or Saturday morning with a photo ID to receive their delegate wristband to wear in order to vote. Voting delegates must be wearing a wristband in order to vote at the Sunday Board of Directors Meeting.
